Should I Apply

In order to apply for a Habitat Home, you must meet the following requirements: There may be more requirements.

Income Guidelines

*Each household must meet a minimum annual gross income as well as a maximum. This is just a guideline. Income figures are subject to change annually according to federal guidelines.

Additional Requirements Include:

- One year stable employment/income history with good references. Recurring income of at least \$1,300 per month. More will be needed depending on the number of people in the home and your monthly cash flow analysis.
- 2) Must have lived in **Cleveland/Bradley County** for at least **one year**.
- 3) One year stable rent history with good references.
- 4) Reasonable credit with good references.
- 5) Must be **out of bankruptcy** with successful discharge for at least **2 years**.
- 6) Willing to work 300-400 hours of sweat equity to include homebuyer education classes, work at the ReStore and assist with the construction of homes (about 25-50 hours per month).
- 7) Ability to pay closing cost in the amount of \$2,500 within 9-12 months.
- 8) Must be a US Citizen or legal resident.
